PUBLICATION ORDER

WHEREAS the Court having read and considered the proposed Notice of Wage & Hour
 Class Action Lawsuit; and

WHEREAS the Court ^{by Decision & Order of this date} ~~found~~ that there exist substantial and sufficient grounds for
 entering this Order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. On or before thirty (30) days after entry of this Order, Defendants shall furnish
 Class Counsel with a list containing the following information: (a) the names of all individuals
 who performed work in food service positions at catered and banquet events at Defendants'
 Renaissance Westchester Hotel from January 2010 through the present (collectively "Class
 Members"); (b) the last known mailing and email address for Class Members; (c) the last known
 telephone number for Class Members; (d) the number of hours worked and/or wages earned while
 performing work in food service positions at Defendants' catered and banquet events; and, (e) the

Social Security numbers for Class Members. To the extent possible, this list is to be furnished in electronic form in CSV or Excel format.

2. On or before forty-five (45) days after entry of this Order, Plaintiffs or their designated representatives shall cause a copy of the Notice of Class Action Lawsuit to be mailed to every Class Member (a) once by first class mail and (b) four times by electronic mail every other Monday during a consecutive eight-week span.

3. On or before forty-five (45) days after entry of this Order, Class Counsel shall cause a copy of the Notice of Class Action Lawsuit to be made available at a designated location on Class Counsels' website located at: www.leedsbrownlaw.com and/or on its Facebook page.

4. On or before forty-five (45) days after entry of this Order, Class Counsel may provide social media notice to Class Members via Linked In messages and via other social media, including Twitter.


5. The Court approves the form of Notice of Class Action and finds that the publication of such Notice of Class Action Lawsuit substantially in the manner and form set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 will constitute the best notice practicable under the circumstances to members of the Class.
