On or before forty-five (45) days after entry of this Order, the Plaintiffs or their designated representatives shall cause a copy of the Notice to be mailed to every Class Member (a) once by first class mail and (b) four times by electronic mail every Monday during a consecutive eight-week span.

- 5.
